

Resolution to Adopt ELearning Program in Lieu of District's Emergency Days

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Heritage CUSD #8 is adopting and ELearning Program district-wide that shall permit instruction to be received electronically, or via pre-planned extended learning while students are not physically present in lieu of the district's scheduled emergency days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Heritage CUSD #8 that it will employ an ELearning Program that:

- May utilize a combination of written and electronic opportunities to provide for instruction and interaction between teachers and students of Heritage CUSD #8
- Ensures and verifies the required clock hours of instruction or school work for each student participating in an ELearning Day.
- Ensures access to electronic or written access for all students participating in the program
- Ensures appropriate learning opportunities for the needs of all learners
- Provides effective notice to students and their parents/guardians of the particular days for ELearning
- Ensures an opportunity for any collective bargaining negotiations that would legally be required
- Monitors and reviews the ELearning program as implemented to address difficulties confronted through revision or otherwise
- Ensures that general expectations and responsibilities of the program are communicated to staff, students, and parents at least 30 days prior to utilization
- Will be verified by the Regional Office of Education for the school district to ensure access for all students
- Will be implemented for a period of two years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 prior to renewal (ISBE Remote Learning Days Guidelines may alter this timeline as required).
